

## DAILY INFANT SCHEDULE

<b>TIME</b>	<b>ACTIVITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION/SKILL FOCUS</b>
6:30 – 8:30	Drop off	Children will eat breakfast, wash hands, get diapers changed, teacher facilitated free play.
8:30 – 8:45	Morning Snack	Children who are eating food will have snack. Teacher will assist in hand washing before and after snack.
8:45 – 9:45	Social Skills/Interaction	Teacher facilitated play giving the children an opportunity to explore their environment and build social skills.
9:15 – 9:30	Music	Teacher will sing songs with the children. Older infants can play with age appropriate musical instruments.
9:30 – 10:15	Physical Fitness/Large Motor Development	Teacher can help smaller infants learn to grasp a rattle. Teacher can work on walking, crawling, and sitting up with older infants.
10:15 – 11:00	Group Activity/Sensory	Teacher can play with smaller infants on texture mat. Older infants can play in sand/water table.
11:00 – 11:15	Story Time	Teacher will read an age appropriate book to the children.
11:15 – 11:30	Wash Hands for Lunch/Safety/Health	Teachers will change diapers and help the children wash their hands.
11:30 – 12:00	Lunch	Children will eat lunch and wash hands when done.
12:00 – 2:30	Nap	Children will sleep or engage in quiet activities while the other children sleep.
2:30 – 3:00	Afternoon Snack	Children who are eating food will have snack. Teacher will assist in hand washing before and after snack.
3:00 – 3:45	Group Activity/Manipulatives	Teacher can hold black and white objects such as a mobile up to catch the smaller infant's attention. Older infants can practice eye-hand coordination by rolling a ball.
3:45 – 4:00	Oral Motor Development/Language	Teacher will show children a flash card and softly talk about what is being shown on the flashcard.
4:00 – 4:45	Physical Development/Large Motor Development	Teacher will play on floor with smaller infants on their tummy to develop muscles. Teacher will sing songs and help older infants do the movements.
4:45 – 5:15	Social Skills/Interaction	Teacher facilitated play giving the children an opportunity to explore their environment and build social skills.
5:15 – 6:00	Clean Up/Closing Circle	Clean up the classroom and teacher facilitated free play while waiting to go home.

\*Diapers will be checked after each feeding and as needed. Feeding and nap times may be different according to parental discretion.
